Galatians 5:22 says, "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." The fruit of God's Holy Spirit are essential character qualities of God Himself.

God *loves* us unconditionally, but does not force us to love Him. God wants us to choose to love and follow Him. God is full of *joy*; God is not depressed or sad. He is very much alive and well. God is at *peace*; He has nothing to worry about because he is God. He also wants us to be at peace, knowing we have eternal life.

God is *patient* with us; He puts up with a lot more from us than He has to.

God is *kind* with us; He sent his Son to die for us. God is *good*; there is nothing evil about God. Every good thing we have comes from God. God is *faithful*; He follows through on his promises. God is *gentle*; He cares about us and listens to our prayers.

God exerts *self-control*; The Bible gives many examples of God's willingness to forgive His wayward people. These qualities tell us a lot about the character of God – and the qualities we strive for in our everyday lives.

Children's Message

First Scripture Lesson: Luke 15:11b-20 Parable of the Prodigal Son Lay Leader

Jesus told them this story: "A man had two sons. The younger son told his father, 'I want my share of your estate now before you die.' So his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons.

"A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land, and there he wasted all his money in wild living. About the time his money ran out, a great famine swept over the land, and he began to starve. He persuaded a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.

"When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger! I will go home to my father and say, "Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant."'"

"So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him.

Second Scripture Lesson Exodus 34:1-8 Moses Makes New Tablets

The Lord said to Moses, "Cut for yourself two tablets of stone like the first, and I will write on the tablets the words that were on the first tablets, which you broke. Be ready by the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself there to me on the top of the mountain. No one shall come up with you, and let no one be seen throughout all the mountain. Let no flocks or herds graze opposite that mountain."

So Moses cut two tablets of stone like the first. And he rose early in the morning and went up on Mount Sinai, as the Lord had commanded him, and took in his hand two tablets of stone. The Lord descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the Lord.
