Preparing Ourselves for Worship During the Prelude...

Go watch a family playing together in a swimming pool sometime. The father is in the water and the children are standing on the edge of the pool, dripping wet and giggling. One at a time, again and again, the children leap out over the water, trusting completely that their father will catch them. He doesn't disappoint. There may be a few near misses, but the father is focused on his task, and is determined to be reliable, which he is. This is a metaphor for the life of faith because TRUST in our Heavenly Father is at the heart of it all.

Call to Worship

L: We have come together to praise our Maker,

P: *But we have betrayed the purpose of the Lord.*

L: The Lord is God of Second Chances, and we are invited into the presence of the Holy One.

P: *The problem is that we have sinned against the Lord.*

L: The Lord is God of Second Chances, and the Lord grants us redemption from sin.

P: *But the problem is that our transgressions have estranged us from the Lord.*

L: The Lord is God of Second Chances, and the Lord offers us reconciliation through Christ.

A: *We stand in awe of you, O Lord, who creates, redeems, and reconciles us. Let us praise you with our lips AND our lives.*



Genesis 9: 8-17

God's Covenant with Noah



Then God said to Noah and to his sons with him, 'As for me, I am establishing my covenant with you and your descendants after you, and with every living creature that is with you, the birds, the domestic animals, and every animal of the earth with you, as many as came out of the ark. I establish my covenant with you, that never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of a flood, and never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth.' God said, 'This is the sign of the covenant that I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all future generations: I have set my bow in the clouds, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth.
