Preparing to Meet God

Preparing Ourselves for Worship During the Prelude...



Have you ever considered that God provides us with opportunities to “lean into” difficult situations to prepare us for even more challenging situations in the future? It’s true that when we lean into God, God provides us with the support that is needed. Of course, at times, we may feel uncomfortable – feeling like we are leaning too far and may fall over.

In 1989, almost a million visitors clamored up the 294 steps and peered out over its vertiginous tilt – about 13 feet off plumb and growing by an alarming 0.04 - 0.08 inches per year. Pisa’s historic Leaning Tower, experts warned, had leaned too far and could topple at any time in the next decade or two. So, the 800-year-old white marble structure, one of Italy’s most famous monuments, was closed for nearly 12 years, and for \$25 million of ingenious engineering work, to set it a little straighter.

What might we need to do to straighten up some areas of our lives so that they don’t topple?

First Lesson

Exodus 17: 1-7 Water from the Rock

From the wilderness of Sin the whole congregation of the Israelites journeyed by stages, as the Lord commanded. They camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink. The people quarreled with Moses, and said, 'Give us water to drink.' Moses said to them, 'Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you test the Lord?' But the people thirsted there for water; and the people complained against Moses and said, 'Why did you bring us out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and livestock with thirst?' So Moses cried out to the Lord, 'What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me.' The Lord said to Moses, 'Go on ahead of the people, and take some of the elders of Israel with you; take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go. I will be standing there in front of you on the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it, so that the people may drink.' Moses did so, in the sight of the elders of Israel.



He called the place Massah and Meribah, because the Israelites quarreled and tested the Lord, saying, 'Is the Lord among us or not?'

Second Lesson Psalm 78: 1-4, 12-16 God's Goodness and Israel's Ingratitude

Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth. I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, things that we have heard and known, that our ancestors have told us. We will not hide them from their children; we will tell to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the Lord, and his might, and the wonders that he has done.

In the sight of their ancestors he worked marvels in the land of Egypt, in the fields of Zoan. He divided the sea and let them pass through it, and made the waters stand like a heap. In the daytime he led them with a cloud, and all night long with a fiery light. He split rocks open in the wilderness, and gave them drink abundantly as from the deep. He made streams come out of the rock, and caused waters to flow down like rivers.
