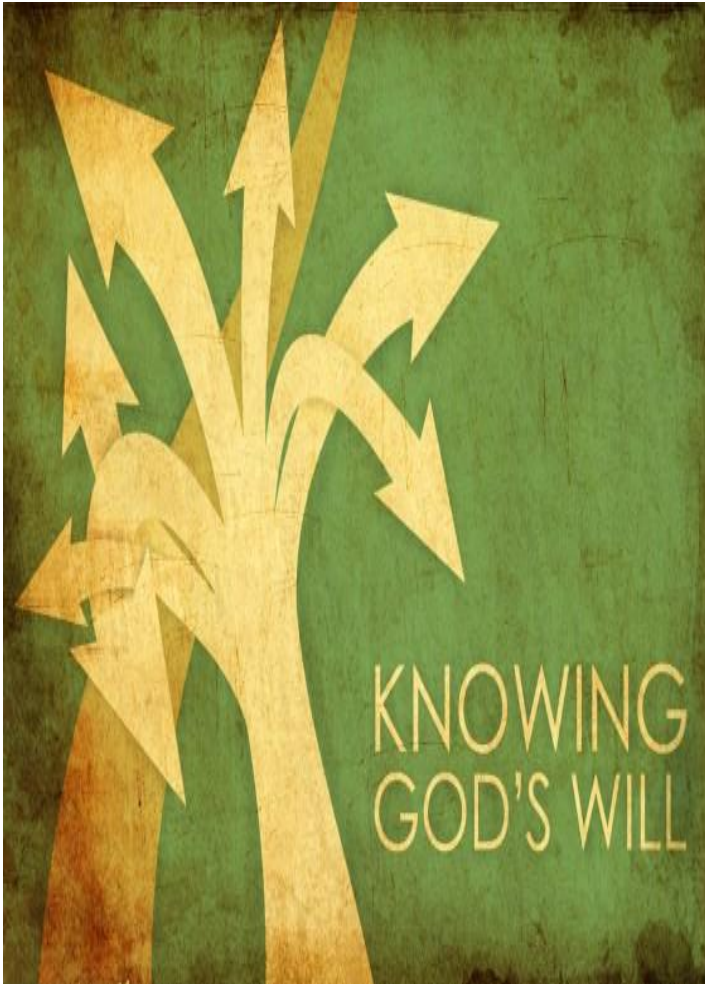

Preparing Ourselves for Worship During the Musical Prelude ...



The great lesson from the true mystics is that the Sacred is in the ordinary – that it is to be found in one's daily life, in one's neighbors, friends, family and in one's backyard. To be looking elsewhere for miracles is to me a sure sign of ignorance and a lack of discernment. (Abraham Maslow)

A problem of discernment from the Eastern Orthodox tradition: There was a monk who rode an ox into town. The people noticed that he was looking all around, as though he were seeking something. They asked him what he was looking for and he said, "I'm looking for an ox" and the townspeople laughed at this foolish man. He went into two other neighborhoods and people in each place asked him the same question, and again he answered, "I'm looking for an ox." Finally, someone said to him, "This is ridiculous because you are a man riding an ox and yet you are looking for an ox." The monk answered, "So it is with you looking for God." This story sounds quite similar to the one about a man looking for a pair of eyeglasses which he, in fact, was wearing.

Call to Worship

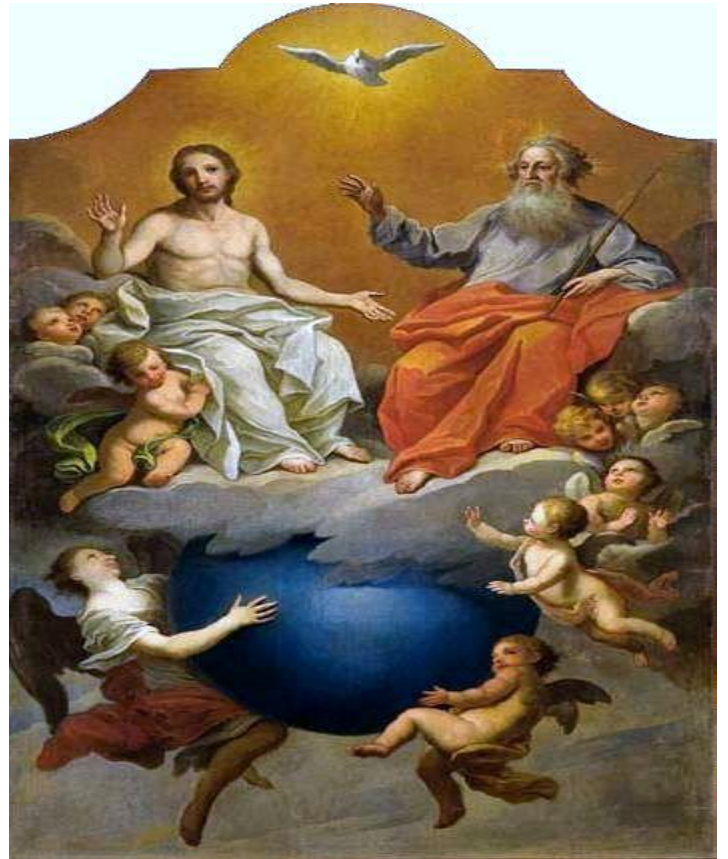
God of the Ages, Whose Almighty Hand
