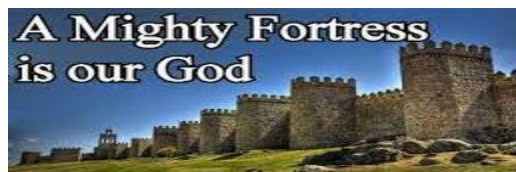

First Lesson *Psalm 104: 24, 27-30* *The Creator and His Creatures* Lay Leader



O Lord, how manifold are your works! In wisdom you have made them all; the earth is full of your creatures. When you hide your face, they are dismayed; when you take away their breath, they die and return to their dust. Second Lesson *Matthew 22: 34-40* *The Greatest Commandment* Carol

When the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together, and one of them, a lawyer, asked him a question to test him. 'Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?' He said to him, ' "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind."
